## Spring is Just Around the Corner

Even though we haven't had winter yet. It is time to think about your spring gardens. Flower bulbs need to be planted in the fall. Many varieties of bulbs do well in this area. The most common are daffodil's, tulips, crocuses', but consider some of the less common bulbs that can add depth and variety to your gardens. Aconite, Bluebells, Grape Hyacinth, Hyacinth, Snowdrops, Snow Glories, Windflowers are some others to consider.



If you have trouble with animals digging up your bulbs after planting them. Try covering with chicken wire than put the rest of your dirt on top. This will deter most thieves. Also remember to use a good bulb booster for a lovely spring showing of flowers.

When planting garlic for next year remember to plant after the first frost. Plant at least 3—4 inches deep. 🌱



## Garden Tip

With the hard winter we had last year. An ounce of prevention may be in order. Cover the crowns on your roses. Cut back all dead stocks from plants. Try to protect flowers by covering with straw (do not use old leaves or hay). This is also the time to think about dividing Bearded iris, digging up your dahlias. Taking care of your garden now — will make it a lot easier in the spring. 🌱
