## Tree Planting

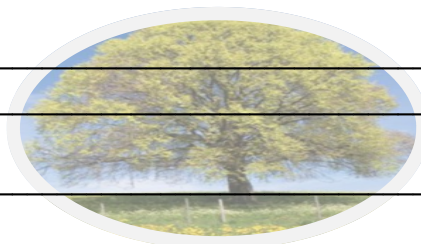
Fall is the best time to plant trees. Native trees are often more adaptable to natural environments, and can have greater resistance to droughts and insects. Some of the common trees in our area that do well:

Black & White Ash  
Birch  
Buckeyes  
Black Cherry  
American Chestnut  
Dogwood  
American Elm  
Hemlock (*state tree*)  
Bitternut & Mockernut  
Hickory  
Black Locust  
Maple  
Pin Oak

White Oak  
*(Revolutionary War frigate, USS Constitution, "Old Ironsides"—was made out of White Oak*  
White Pine  
Sycamore  
Willow (*must be planted in a moist area*)  
Witch Hazel  
Black Walnut
